Dear Parents,

The Montrose School District's results of the Dakota STEP test given last spring are now available. The Dakota STEP test is the assessment tool used by the state to meet the No Child Left Behind (NCLB) legislation. NCLB requires that every school district test students in grades 3-8 and 11 in the areas of reading and math. Grades 5, 8, and 11 are also assessed in science. The state applied for a waiver from the federal government and it was granted. Due to the waiver, Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) will not be calculated this year. A detailed breakdown of the test scores may be viewed at www.doe.sd.gov. Click on "Report Card" under the Quick Links on the left. The District will also provide colored copies in the District Office and City Finance Office of this report. Parents of students in the above mentioned grades should have also received an individual report from Mrs. Jarrett on their child's Dakota STEP results. These results were mailed with a letter dated August 28, 2012.

The State Report Card presents Dakota STEP test data in two slightly different reports, an Accountability Report and an Assessment Report.

- The Accountability Report compiles the Dakota STEP score results from students who attended Montrose School District from October 1 through the last day of testing. This is the information upon which Adequate Yearly Progress determinations were based.
- The Assessment Report represents the scores of all students in the Montrose School District, not just those who completed the full academic year.

The tables provided represent the results of the Dakota STEP testing. The first chart shows results for all students tested in the state of South Dakota. The second chart shows South Dakota results of the National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP). The third chart shows results of all students in grades 3-8 and 11 in the Montrose School District. The other charts have the data broken down by attendance center (Montrose Elementary School, Montrose Middle School, Montrose High School and Orland Colony School).
